Your Severance Council, through the efforts of our Administration and Staff, have been very busy throughout the winter and into spring. After getting the budget in place, planning for the upcoming year can go into full swing. I am sure most have watched the Severance branch of the Clearview Library being built with anticipation of its opening. The time is near - April 6th, 2024 at 1 PM. Our Police will soon have a new home located where they presently reside. The demolition of the site will begin April 29th, 2024. Keep your eyes open for future announcements. Solar power lights have been installed at several parks throughout Severance. The installation was made possible using a \$300K grant and at no cost to the residents.

In our communication efforts with the community, the Council hosted a State of the Town event replacing one of our normal business We were worried about the meetings. attendance. Would we have an audience? What kind of questions would we expect? The outcome was beyond our expectations and the questions and comments were excellent.

Discussions were informative and embodied a mutual respect amongst participants.

Following the meeting it leaves me with a wealth of information and a positive feeling about the planning for the Town of Severance. #### The Great Western Trail is Open Connects Windsor, Severance, and Eaton

To celebrate completion of the final section of the Great Western Trail in August 2023, the Great Western Trail Foundation is sponsoring the inaugural Great Western Trail Race. The event is scheduled for Saturday, April 20th, and includes officially timed distance runs of 5K, 10K and Half-Marathon. Race registration is open now at http://runsignup.com/Race/CO/Windsor/GreatWesternTrailRace

The race is produced by run.Windsor, and a portion of proceeds from race entries will be donated to the Windsor Community Foundation. Additionally, local businesses can donate directly to the Great Western Trail Foundation by sponsoring customized Mile Marker signs to be placed along the race courses. The start/finish area for all 3 distances is at Severance Community Park, where the post-race Festival will also be held. At about 11:00 am, a ceremonial ribbon cutting will be held to celebrate the trail's completion, along with recognition of the funding partners that made the Great Western Trail possible. Music, a bounce-house, food & beverage trucks and race sponsor displays are some of the Festival activities planned. 


