## LICENSE DESCRIPTION:

Class A (Commercial & Residential)	Entitles the holder to construct, alter, finish, or repair any type or size of structure permitted by the International Building Code or the International Residential Code as adopted by the town; entitles holder to construct, alter, or repair one-family and two-family residences of two stories or less as permitted by the International Residential Code as adopted by Town and entitles holder to perform work involving specialized trades, not including roofing - subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town.	Demonstrate competence through passage of an examination administered by the ICC, or submittal of proof of current registration, or license of the same, or equivalent license classification, from a governmental entity that requires ICC testing as part of its registration or licensing process; certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence.
Class B (Residential)	Entitles holder to construct, alter, or repair one-family and two-family residences of two stories or less as permitted by the International Residential Code as adopted by Town - subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town.	Demonstrate competence through passage of an examination administered by the ICC, or submittal of proof of current registration, or license of the same, or equivalent license classification, from a governmental entity that requires ICC testing as part of its registration or licensing process; certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence.
Class B2 (Specialized Residential)	Solar (requires a Colorado master electrician license and a Colorado State electrical contractor license); Fences; Pools/Spas- subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town.	May require testing. Submittal of proof of current registration, or license of the same, or equivalent license classification, from a governmental entity that requires testing as part of its registration or licensing process; Certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence. Class C (Sub- contractor or tradesman)	Entitles holder to perform work involving specialized trades, not including roofing - subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town (i.e., HVAC, Fire Sprinkler, Concrete/Masonry; Frame; Window Installers – repair/replacement only); Excavating; Signage (not an all-inclusive list))	Copy of State License for Electrical and Plumbing; Master Licenses, Driver's License/State Issued ID; certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence. Proof of current State certification as a Fire Suppression System Contractor through the Colorado Division of Fire Prevention and Control.

(Roofing)  Commercial Roofing (Covers both Residential and Commercial)	Entitles holder to engage in the installation of roofing materials on commercial building structures permitted by the town's building code - subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town	International Code Council, G14 or F14 Certification; Demonstrate competence through passage of an examination administered by the ICC or submittal of proof of current registration, or license of the same, or equivalent license classification, from a governmental entity that requires ICC testing as part of its registration or licensing process; certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence.
Residential Roofing	Entitles holder to engage in the installation of roofing materials on residential building structures permitted by the town's building code - subject to suspension and/or revocation by Town	Demonstrate competence through passage of an examination administered by the ICC G15 or F15, or submittal of proof of current registration, or license of the same, or equivalent license classification, from a governmental entity that requires ICC testing as part of its registration or licensing process; certificate of insurance from an agent or insurance company demonstrating that the applicant has workers' compensation insurance in the statutorily required amounts, general commercial or liability insurance with minimum limits of not less than \$100,000.00 each occurrence and \$300,000.00 general aggregate, and automobile liability insurance with minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$300,000.00 for any occurrence.
