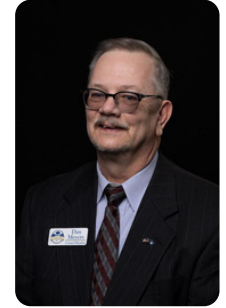

The Town of Severance is now accepting letters of interest with resumes for a vacant Town Council Member seat. To be considered for this appointment, you must be a registered elector of the Town and eligible to vote, and a resident of the Town for no less than twelve (12) consecutive months.

Letters of interest explaining your qualifications and interest in the vacant seat should be addressed to the Mayor and Town Council, Attn: Nicholas Wharton, Town Manager, and may either be sent to Severance Town Hall, 3 S. Timber Ridge Pkwy., P.O. Box 339, Severance, CO 80546, or via email at lcoombes@townofseverance.org.

Letters of interest will be accepted until Monday, May 31, 2024, at 5:00 PM. The Town Council will appoint a Council Member at the June 11th Council Meeting. Interested residents will be expected to attend this meeting, provide an introduction of themselves, and answer any questions the Town Council may have.
